

Tools Required: Phillips Head Screwdriver Parts Included: 1x AS-4334 with Hardware 1x AS-4274 Ram – Side Clamp (Accessory) 1x AS-4295 USB Secure Storage (Accessory)

- 1. Before beginning, locate the hardware pack labeled 021-8015, shown in **Figure 1.**
- 2. Next, locate the bottom clamp, the top clamp, and the main plate as shown in Figure 2.






Figure 3. Top/Bottom Clamp Fit on Main Plate

- 3. Slide the top clamp and bottom clamp into the main plate and over the pins (facing downwards) as shown in Figure 3.

4. Next, locate three ½" plastic spacers (shown in Figure 4) and three M5 washers (shown in Figure 5).




Figure 6. Attached 1/4" spacers to pins.

- 5. Place the three ¼" plastic spacers on top of the three pins that the top and bottom plate slid into (in step 3 and shown in Figure 3.) as shown in Figure 6 for reference. The three M5 washers will be placed on top of the three spacers.
- Next, locate three smaller M5 x 8 mm screws (shown in Figure 7), and fasten them to the pins of the main plate (shown in Figure 8).
 NOTE: Do not completely tighten these screws. These screws will be tightened once your tablet is fastened in place inside of the tablet clamp.




Figure 9. Side Clamps on Main Plate

- 7. Obtain the two side clamps and secure them to the back of the main plate (Shown in Figure 9.)




Figure 10. Side Clamps secured to Main Plate

- 8. Using the same M5 washers (shown in Figure 5.) and the same M5 x 8 mm screws (shown in Figure 7), secure the side plates to the main plate, shown in Figure 10. **NOTE: Do not completely tighten these screws. These screws will be tightened once your tablet is fastened in place inside of the tablet clamp.**




Figure 11. Adhesive Rectangle Padding

- 9. Obtain the four adhesive rectangle padding (Shown in Figure 11).




Figure 12. Adhesive Rectangle Padding Placement

- 10. Next, turn the tablet clamp over 180 degrees in order to place the four adhesive rectangle padding where your tablet will be placed. Use Figure 12 for reference.
- 11. Place your tablet inside of the clamp, securing the top, bottom, and side clamps to the edge of the tablet as you see fit. Once the clamps are placed in your appropriate setting, tighten the seven M5 x 8 mm screws on the back of the clamp.

- 12. Obtain the 4x ½" spacer (Figure 13) and the 4x M5 x 20mm screws (Figure 14).
- 13. On the back of the tablet clamp, place the remaining two plastic covers over the two pins with the aforementioned ½" spacers, as shown in Figure 15.

- 14. Next, beginning by screwing in the top M5 x 20mm screw with, place the tablet clamp onto the vesa mount of the FSC-10 you have received. An example of this can be seen in Figure 16.
- 15. Once the top screws have been screwed in and the tablet is secure, screw in the remaining two bottom screws with the M5 x 20 mm screws (Figure 17).

AS-4295 USB Lock Assembly

- If installing a USB Secure Storage, an additional AS-4295 Storage bracket and custom AS-4274 side clamp should have been sent with the AS-4334 Tablet Clamp. An example of these two pieces can be found in Figure 19.
- 2. These will be fastened together using two 8-32 x 1/4 screws. An example of the put together USB bracket can be seen in Figure 20.
- 3. Once you have assembled the bracket, this will be used in place of a side bracket of your choosing, shown in Steps 7 and 8 as well as in Figures 9 and 10.
